



### Directions to Jett Title

#### Quick:

We are at the intersection of Richmond Rd. and New Cr. Rd., behind Bob Evans. Must enter through the Bob Evans' parking lot. The Jett Title Building resembles an "upside down pyramid" and is clearly visible from new Cr. Rd.

#### Detailed:

##### Going out-bound on Richmond Rd. (traveling East):

1. Go under New Cr. then immediately turn right onto the access road – which goes to wards Bob Evans.
2. Enter the Bob Evans lot and go thru it. Our building is in the rear of Bob Evans. It resembles an "upside down pyramid."

##### Coming in-bound on Richmond Rd. (traveling West):

1. Drive past Lowes on your right.
2. Pass the light at Todd's Rd (on your right) & Patchen Drive (on your left).
3. Get into the left lane.
4. Turn left at McDonalds/Q'Doba light. This is the last light before you go underneath New Cr. Rd. At this light, on your *right*, will be the Applebees/ Panera/ Sheraton Shuites -FKA French-Qtr Suites - shopping center.
5. Just after you have turned left at this light, immediately turn right onto the access-road in front of McDonalds.
6. Pass McDonalds and turn left into the Bob Evans lot. Go thru it. Our building is in the rear of Bob Evans. It resembles an "upside down pyramid."

##### From the "outside" circle of New Cr. Rd. (traveling North/East):

1. Take the Richmond Rd. exit.
2. As you proceed down the exit ramp, the building is seen on your right. It resembles an "upside down pyramid."
3. Turn right off the exit ramp then immediately turn right onto the access road which goes to wards Bob Evans.
4. Enter the Bob Evans lot and go thru it. Our building is in the rear of Bob Evans.

##### From the "inside" circle of New Cr. Rd (traveling South/East):

1. Pass Freedom Dodge on your right & Woodhill Shopping Center on your left.
2. Take the Richmond Rd. exit.
3. Turn left off the exit ramp.
4. Go under New Cr. then immediately turn right onto the access road which goes to wards Bob Evans.
5. Enter the Bob Evans lot and go thru it. Our building is in the rear of Bob Evans. It resembles an "upside down pyramid."
